

SETS Program: Support for Young People from Refugee & Migrant Backgrounds

What is SETS?

SETS (Settlement Engagement and Transition Support) program provides casework to people from refugee and migrant backgrounds on selected visas throughout their settlement journey.

SETS Youth Case Worker

The SETS Youth Case Worker provides case management to young people (12-25) on eligible visas within the Perth Metro area. The case worker will meet the young person in their local area to assist with ongoing goals throughout their settlement journey. This includes:

- referral pathways relating to services such as employment, education, and wellbeing
- advocacy and service navigation with matters such as Centrelink, housing, and health
- building Community connection with access to sport, recreation, and life skill programs
