# **COURSES & DELIVERY**

In conjunction with RII20720 Certificate II in Civil Construction learners will undertake FSK20119 and external short courses as needed (First Aid, WHS, driving lessons).

Year 11 students: 2-year course, FSK 4 days a week and Civil Construction 1 day. Year 12 students: 1-year course, FSK 3 days a week and Civil Construction 2 days.
